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## **SUPERVISION NEWS: Motivo (Formerly LMFT CONNECT) Wins Award!**

The number of Approved Supervisors in GA has steadily increased over the past few years. Nevertheless, securing MFT supervision which meets Composite Board standards continues to be a challenge for many MFT interns and new graduates. Several years ago, GAMFT member and Approved Supervisor, Rachel McCrickard created a highly innovative and HIPAA compliant internet video platform designed to connect Approved Supervisors and Supervisors-in-Training with interns and new graduates needing to acquire Board approved supervision to complete requirements for licensure. The platform, known at that time as LMFT Connect, quickly attracted many Supervisors and Supervisors-In-Training and today GA represents the state with the most MFT Approved Supervisors on the Motivo Directory of Supervisors. One of the initial goals of LMFT Connect was to make approved supervision readily available to those practicing in areas where there is no local Approved Supervisor. Another important goal was to make the cost of supervision reasonable and affordable. Soon LMFT Connect began receiving requests for supervision from disciplines other than MFT which led to an expansion of the original vision and a change of name so that, in 2017, LMFT Connect became MOTIVO. Although the name has changed and the scope of the vision has enlarged, the original commitment of providing affordable and accessible MFT Supervision remains the same.

Recently, Motivo was recognized for innovation and excellence by a second place finish in a podcast competition sponsored by WOMEN WHO TECH, an organization which seeks to promote and fund women-led, technology start-ups. A group of women from 23 different countries and 5 continents entered podcasts describing their video platforms and target audiences. In her podcast, Ms. McCrickard describes Motivo and the opportunities it offers to those seeking clinical supervision from Approved or Certified Supervisors. 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## **“MIDTERM” GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 6**

### **Legislative/Governmental Affairs Committee**

The general election for the U.S. House of Representatives, Georgia statewide offices, and representatives and senators in the Georgia General Assembly will be held on November 6. GAMFT does not endorse particular candidates – we realize that our members will back various candidates, each for their own reasons. However, we do report on the contributions of those candidates who have played a key role in GAMFT’s legislative agenda, so that our members have this information when considering which candidates to support. The following are two such candidates:

#### **GEORGIA SENATE**

**Fran Millar (R, District 40 – Dunwoody)** In 2013 and 2014, Senator Millar sponsored GAMFT’s bill to add “diagnose” to the Scope of Practice for MFTs. In 2013 the Georgia Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities had ruled that, in all state mental health centers and in all agencies that contract with the state, a diagnosis could only be provided by a professional with “diagnose” in their Scope of Practice – thereby prohibiting MFTs from providing a diagnosis for their clients. Affording MFTs the statutory authority to diagnose not only reversed the effect of this ruling, it also protected Georgia MFTs from future potential problems like what occurred in Texas, where a legal challenge resulted in a lengthy court battle over MFTs diagnosing. Senator Millar not only sponsored our bill, he actively championed our cause. It is safe to say that without Senator Millar’s support, MFTs might not have the legal authority to diagnose.

Senate District 40 includes most of north Dekalb County, along with adjoining small pieces of Fulton and Gwinnett Counties.

#### **GEORGIA HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**

**Mary Francis Williams (D, District 37 – Marietta)** Back in 1984 a coalition of professional counselors, social workers and marriage and family therapists passed legislation establishing licenses for our three professions. But one group who opposed our licenses – in coordination with the Chair of the House Appropriations Committee – added a “poison pill” clause to our bill stipulating that the law would not go into effect until moneys were appropriated to fund the Board. Mary Francis, a newly graduated social worker, had a longstanding family friendship with the House Majority Leader – a friendship strong enough that she was

able to enlist him to do battle on our behalf, facing down the Appropriations Committee Chair and obtaining funding for our Board, thereby implementing our licensing law. It is safe to say that without Mary Francis’ intervention, we might not have a license.

Mary Francis is not currently a State Representative. For most of her career she has worked as a lobbyist advocating on behalf of children’s issues at the capitol. Upon her retirement from lobbying she was recruited to run against the current representative in House District 37, which includes Marietta and an adjoining portion of Cobb County southwest of Marietta.
